## THE OLYMPIC PUSH IS OVER, YOU’RE RESTED UP, AND NOW IT’S TIME TO GET YOUR SOCIAL ON!

The Leagues Committee is excited to offer several Social Leagues at new times! For those who have not curled in the Social Leagues, these leagues are about having fun and socializing! It’s simple, **we curl, and we broom stack**—no stats are kept...beyond who buys the first round! Our broom stacking maybe enhanced by snacks brought by the participants... we put the competitive leagues to shame!

Social League teams are formed to allow our fantastic membership base to get to know each other. For the upcoming Social Leagues, teams will be formed to include 2-3 newbies with a couple of experienced players. You can register as an individual or request to play with a friend.

The exciting news for players who participate in the Summer Social Leagues—**you could play for FREE!** Of course, there are stipulations, but you could **REALLY. PLAY. FOR. FREE!** Here’s the catch, you must be a paid player in at least one summer league (Competitive or Social). Then, you are eligible to play in all 3 of the Summer Social Leagues **FOR FREE!** The Summer Social Leagues are scheduled to play on Friday nights, Saturday afternoons and Sunday evenings.

For example, a “Competitive Player” would pay to play in Tuesday and/or Thursday Leagues. If they play in Summer Social Leagues on Friday, Saturday and/or Sunday, they would **PLAY FOR FREE!** For the player who is a “Social Player,” they will pay to play in the 7-week Saturday Happy Hour Summer Social League (or the most expensive Summer Social League for which they are registered) but can **PLAY FOR FREE** in the 5-week Friday Fun Social League and/or 5-week Funday Sunday League.

Summer Social Leagues will be playing on the following dates and times.

- **Friday Fun League** (session A)—6 games on April 20/27, May 4/18/25 and June 1 starting at 6:30pm. If demand is high, we will have 2 draws. For those new to this lingo, “2 draws” means that there could be 8 teams playing at 6:30 and 8 more teams playing at 8:30; your game time could change from week to week as we attempt to share early and late draws as evenly as possible. **REGISTRATION IS OPEN NOW!!**
- **Friday Fun League** (session B)—5 games on June 8/15/22/29 and July 6 at 6:30pm. If demand is high, we will have 2 draws.
- **Saturday Happy Hour League**—7 games on May 26, June 2/9/16/23/30 and July 7 from 4-6pm. This league will be limited to 1 draw.
- **Funday Sunday League** (session A)—5 games on May 6/13/20/27 and June 3 at 4:15pm. If demand is high, we will have 2 draws with 8 teams playing in the first draw and 4 teams playing in the second draw which would start at 6:30pm.
- **Funday Sunday League** (session B)—5 games on June 10/17/24 and July 1/8 at 4:15pm. If demand is high, we will have 2 draws with 8 teams playing in the first draw and 4 teams playing in the second draw which would start at 6:30pm.
